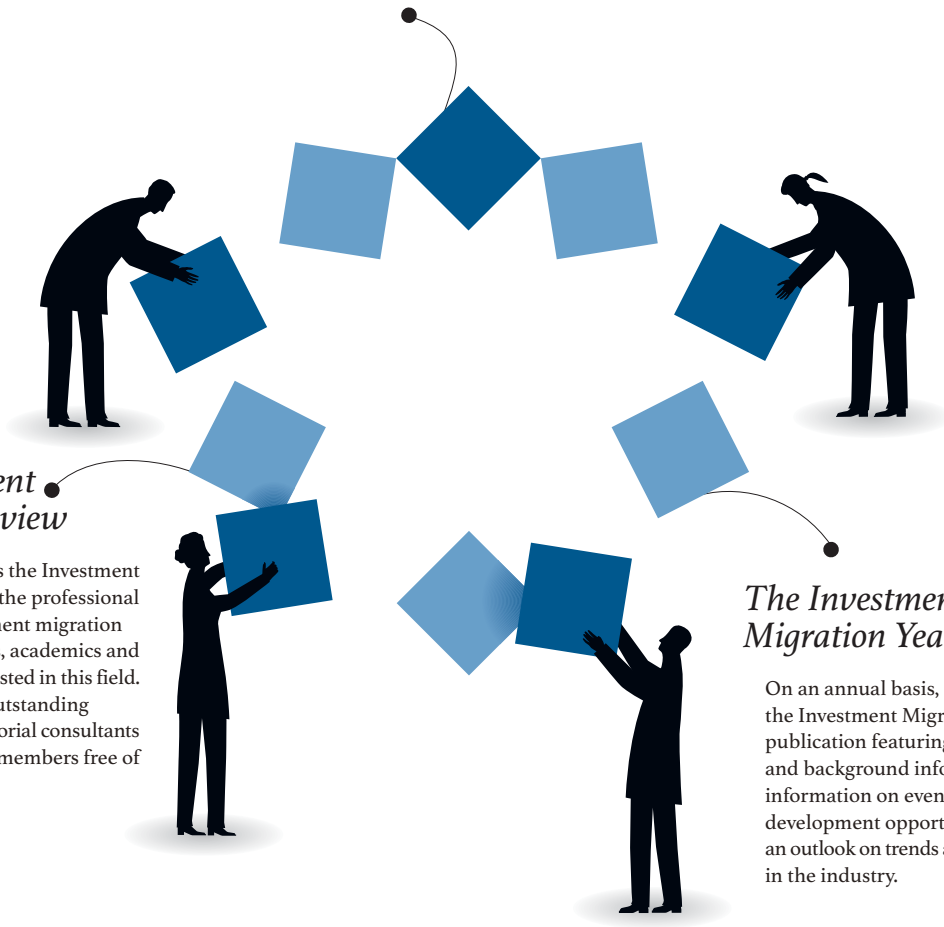

The Investment Migration Yearbook

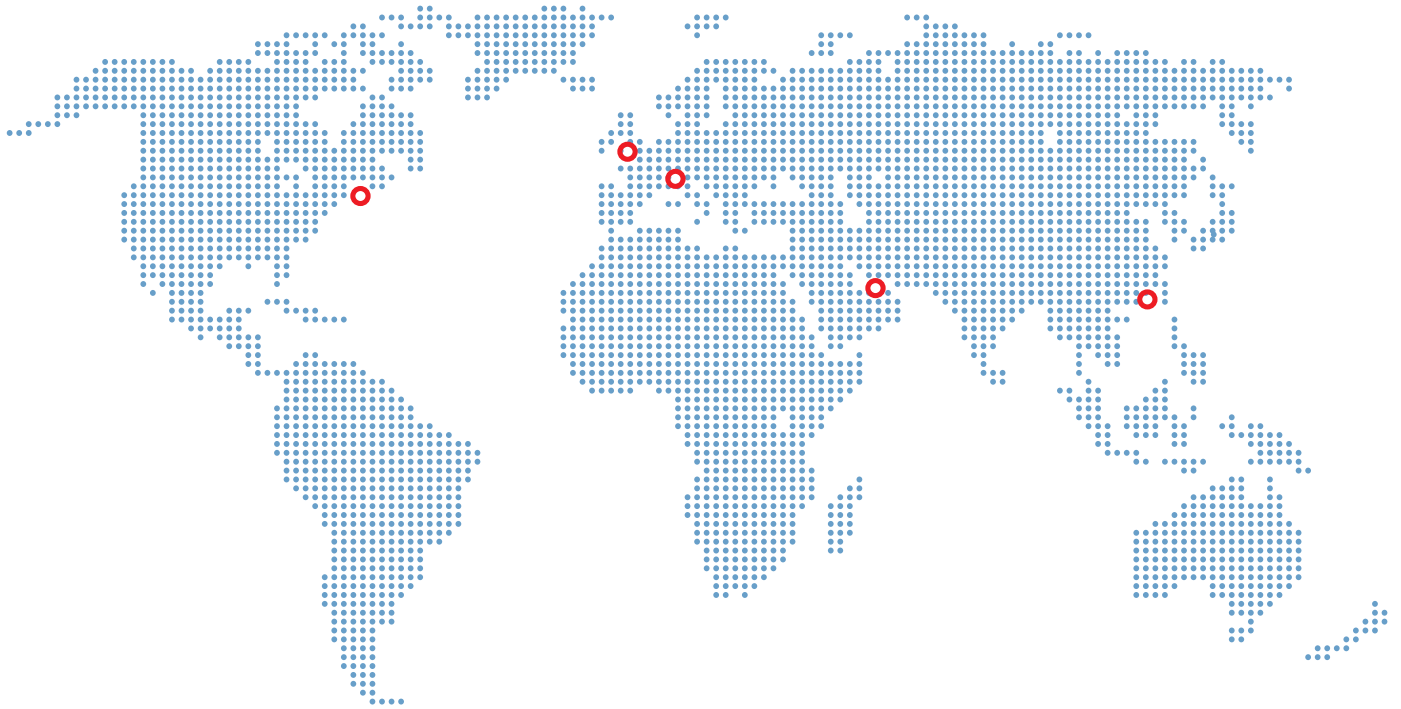

Organisation /

The IMC was founded as a not-for-profit Association under Swiss law. Based in Geneva, it has representative offices in New York, London, Dubai and Hong Kong.

Management /

Managed by a Chief Executive Officer under the direction of a Governing Board, the IMC also has a non-executive Advisory Committee, in which the most important industry stakeholders are represented. The IMC organises an annual Forum and other events in which high-level speakers are invited to address issues that are of interest to the global investment migration industry, governments and international organisations. The IMC is funded by membership fees, donors and income from activities such as events, education and training, and publications.
